

## Relationship and Health Education content covered in the Science Curriculum

Year R: Red Class	<p>EYFS curriculum</p> <p>Understand ways to keep healthy and safe.</p> <p>Understand similarities and differences between people, families and communities.</p> <p>Observe animals and plants and observe any changes</p>
Year 1: Orange Class	Naming body parts such as head, neck, face, arms etc. through games, actions, songs and rhymes.
Year 2: Yellow Class	<p>Process of reproduction and growth in animals.</p> <p>Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring, which grow into adults.</p> <p>E.g.: egg, chick, chicken</p> <p>Caterpillar, pupa, butterfly</p> <p>Spawn, tadpole, frog</p> <p>Baby, toddler, child, teenager, adult.</p> <p>They are not expected to understand how reproduction</p>
Year 3: Green Class

Year 5: Purple Class	<p>The changes experienced in puberty, including:</p> <p>Names of sexual organs</p> <p>Periods</p> <p>Wet dreams</p> <p>Time line to indicate stages in the growth and development of humans.</p> <p>Gestation periods of other animals to compare to that of humans.</p>
Year 6: Pink Class	<p>The biological facts about sex and reproduction in a loving relationship.</p> <p>The names of the reproductive organs.</p> <p>How babies are made.</p> <p>How babies are born.</p>
