## **Sun Safety**

As the weather becomes warmer, we want to ensure all pupils remain safe, comfortable and ready to learn throughout the summer term.

### School Uniform

Pupils are expected to wear the appropriate school uniform. This includes:

- Black or grey school shorts, trousers or skirt
- Black closed-toe school shoes (not trainers). Flip flops, crocs or open-toed sandals must not be worn

It is essential that children stay hydrated throughout the school day. Please ensure that they bring to school a named, reusable water bottle. All classrooms have a tap to refill these throughout the school day.
